ENTRY FEE: \$200 (reining only) or \$250 (reining and cow work)

AUDIT ONLY: \$35/day or \$50/weekend

- **Limited to 16 horses/riders.
- **Each session is 2 hours with 4 sessions per day and a lunch break mid-day.
- **Each session will have only 2 compatible horse/rider sets allowing for very intense, personalized, one-on-one instruction from the clinician.
- **Entry fee also includes auditing of all the weekend sessions and lunch each day.
Paid audit only participants also receive lunch daily.
- **Riders may choose reining only or reining and cow work.
- **A **non-refundable** deposit of \$150 is due with this entry form to hold your slot.
Remainder of the entry fee can be paid at the clinic.
All checks are to be made payable to NCRCHA.
- **Entries must be received at least 2 weeks prior to the clinic so we can pair up riders and notify you of your ride time. If you have another rider you would like to ride with, both of you need to indicate that on your registration.
