

Barker Creek All-Around Performance Award

All Breed Declaration Form

The winner of the Barker Creek All-Around Performance Horse will be awarded to a Champion and Grand Champion Horse/Rider combination based on the highest combined total of points earned from any combination of all All-Breed classes **Reining, Cutting/Herd Work, Fence/Boxing Work, and Performance Halter** classes entered on Thursday, Friday or Saturday. Individual "goes" from the NRCHA Bridle Spectacular and Derby will count once per concurrent grouping and have points allocated as individual classes. The point system used will be: first place in every eligible class will receive 10 points, second receives 9 points and so on until tenth place receives 1 point.

- * To be eligible for the award, Horses **must** enter the performance halter class
- * Open to any breed of horse
- * Points will be accumulated for every qualifying all-breed class the Horse/Rider combination enters
- * This declaration form must be on file in the show office before points will be awarded

Champion and Reserve Champion trophy belt buckles will be awarded to the horses with the highest combined total of points from earned scores. In addition, a 60/40 jackpot will be distributed to the Champion and Reserve from a percentage of entry fees from the Performance Horse Halter class.
