Safety Guidelines

1. Hand sanitizer will be located in the show office, the bathrooms and other key locations – for use by the participants.
2. There will be a limit to the individuals in the show office at a time. Please adhere to the floor markings for social distancing.
3. Bleacher chairs are expected to be spaced out to allow for the 6' social distancing, and the aluminum bleacher benches will be marked at 6' intervals to allow for adequate social distance spacing.
4. If you feel you need the added protection of a facemask, please plan to bring your own to wear as NCRCHA will not be providing face masks.

If at any point during the weekend that you begin to feel poorly, please ensure the safety of others at the show and leave the show grounds.
